




2 On page 26+27 Sea glass decorates the border.


22 On page 15 You'll find navigation lights in front of the ice cream shop.


WEATHER FLAGS

What ever happens to it?





Look carefully at the borders of my book. You will see some decorations that look like scrimshaw.






SEA GLASS
